- East London** Jumbie: A Movement - The Movie (1986) Commando (1988)

- Metropolitan** Any Searls and Ellen Wood were given pre-reqs used in Return of the King. They each thought they had the only one.
- Northern** Irving G. Thalberg produced three films that won Best Picture without winning any other Oscars.
- Pecadilly** Kazuo Miyagawa "invented" pointing a camera at the sun.
